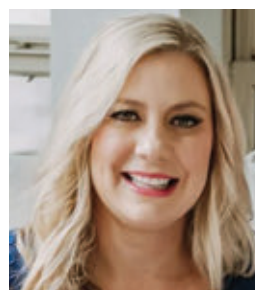
Comptroller of Public Accounts - Don Huffines
